2014 Domaine William Fevre Chablis

1959, the year in which William Fèvre declared his first crop, marked the birth of the domain. Descended from a family which had lived in the Chablis region for over 250 years, it was only natural that he set up as a winemaker with 7 hectares of vineyards.



Over the years the domain has acquired new vineyards in Chablis, all located in the historic terroirs. William Fèvre has become one of the biggest land owners in Chablis with 78 hectares of prestigious vineyards, of which 15.9 are classified as Premiers Crus and 15.2 as Grand Crus.

The Wines

2014 Chablis AC

"A cool, pure and slightly more elegant nose speaks of citrus, oyster shell, white flowers and iodine hints. There is excellent volume for a villages level wine with very good mid-palate concentration present on the medium-bodied flavors that conclude in a citrusy, clean and very dry finale. I very much like the delivery and this too will need at least a year or two of bottle age first. Recommended as overall, this delivers very fine quality. Top value. 89 Points/Drink 2019+" – Allen Meadows, Burghound

2014 Chablis 1er Cru 'Les Lys'

"As is often the case with a good example of Les Lys, the elegant and airy nose is do minated by various floral aromas that include notes of mineral reduction along with cool nuances of tidal pool, shell fish and seaweed. The mouth feel of the middle weight flavors is ultra-fine with flat out terrific delineation on the chiseled, vibrant and tension-filled finale that is notably dry. This is absolutely textbook Les Lys with its combination of finesse and punch. Sweet spot. 90-93 Points/Drink 2019+" – Allen Meadows, Burghound

2014 Chablis 'Vaillons' 1er Cru

"This could be from nowhere else but Chablis with its pungent aromas of oyster shell, mineral reduction, algae, white flowers and citrus rind. There is even better complexity to the delicious, intense and delineated medium weight flavors that also display profuse minerality on the saliva-inducing finish that really fans out as it sits on the palate. Worth considering. 90-92 Points/Drink 2020+" – Allen Meadows, Burghound

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2014 Chablis 'Montee de Tonnerre' 1er Cru

"An ultra-fresh, cool and admirably pure nose features notes of shellfish, pear, mineral reduction and pungent iodine nuances. There is outstanding volume and intensity to the medium weight plus flavors that deliver beautifully focused power on the palate coating, mineral-driven and hugely persistent finale. Once again if tasted blind it would be all but impossible not to identify this as Chablis and a first-rate example at that! Don't miss! 92-94 Points/Drink 2020+" – Allen Meadows, Burghound

2014 Chablis 1er Cru 'Vaulorent'

From a huge 3.63 ha parcel out of only 17 ha and most of it is hard by Les Preuses. Séguier calls this their "baby grand cru" as specific barrels are selected for vine age, concentration and power

"Yet again the ultra-fresh and strikingly layered white flower nose is packed with typical Chablis aromas that include cool mineral reduction, citrus and oyster shell nuances. The medium weight flavors are almost painfully intense while brimming with minerality on the chiseled finish that is tight to the point of being linear. This terrific effort will require at least 5 to 7 years of cellaring to reveal its full, and considerable, potential. In a word, impressive. Don't miss! 92-94 Points/Drink 2021+" – Allen Meadows, Burghound

2014 Chablis 'Les Preuses' Grand Cru

"Along with the Côte Bouguerots and Les Lys, this possesses the most elegant nose in the range with an ultra-pure mixture of green fruit, tidal pool, white flower, citrus rind and iodine hints. There is terrific intensity and delineation to the attractively textured and refined yet powerful flavors that exude a fin e bead of minerality on the gorgeously long, balanced and Zen-like finale. Don't miss! 93-95 Points/Drink 2021+" – Allen Meadows, Burghound

2014 Chablis Bougros 'Cote de Bougerots' Grand Cru

From a 2.2 ha parcel at the bottom section of the vineyard; even so, the vineyard is so steep here that it must be worked entirely by hand as tractors would be dangerous to use.

"Once again, based on the nose alone, this could be nothing else but Chablis with its mélange of tidal pool, mineral reduction, citrus blossom and discreet spice nuances. There is fantastic detail to the focused, mineral-driven and powerful middle weight plus flavors that do a slow build from the mid-palate all the way back to the explosively long, balanced and bone dry finish. This too should amply reward longer-term cellaring but be approachable after only 6 to 8. In a word, wonderful. Don't miss! 93-96 Points/Drink 2021+" – Allen Meadows, Burghound

2014 Chablis 'Les Clos' Grand Cru

"A broad-ranging array features notes of spice, green apple, grapefruit, lemon rind and copious Chablis elements. Remarkably for a wine that is relatively quite refined, the medium-bodied and concentrated flavors are even more powerful than those of the Bougros, all wrapped in a superbly complex, saline and balanced finish where the citrus character telegraphed by the nose reappears on the explosive finale. There is a bit of wood in evidence but I doubt that it will take very long before it is fully integrated. In sum, this is one to strongly consider. Don't miss! 93-96 Points/Drink 2021+" – Allen Meadows, Burghound
