# Jamsheed New Releases

We are delighted to announce the release of the 2014 single-vineyard Syrah's from Jamsheed Wines. Winemaker Gary Mills crafts 4 intriguing Syrah's from across Victoria's premier wine-growing regions – Beechworth, Great Western, The Yarra Valley and The Pyrenees. Winemaking is almost identical for each wine (minimal intervention and a high percentage of whole-bunch fermentation) which allows the unique identity of each region to shine-through.



MW has followed these wines for many years now and after tasting them yesterday, we can honestly say that these are some of the most complete and interesting wines released under the Jamsheed label to date. A horizontal tasting of these wines is simply fascinating. They all speak proudly of their respective *terroirs*, yet each wine offers a unique expression of that region due to the 'old-world' winemaking techniques adopted. These techniques have served the Rhone Valley well for many centuries and we are now starting to appreciate their benefits in Australian wine thanks to Gary Mills. Seek these wines out, you will not be disappointed.

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# The Wines

As there are no critic reviews available, tasting notes have been completed by MW Wines.

### 2014 'Beechworth' Syrah

Sourced from the 'Warner' vineyard in Beechworth. Gary and Rick Kinzbrunner (Giaconda) split the fruit 50/50.

A completely different expression when compared to Giaconda's Warner Vineyard Shiraz. This wine speaks most proudly of the whole-bunch mantra adopted by Gary Mills with (attractive) sappy roast beetroot notes that lace the pure nose of liquorice, blackcurrant liqueur and dark fruits. The palate is medium-weight and sweet on entry, finishing long, with some sneaky fine-but-firm tannins. The 'Beechworth' impresses with its character and unique expression, however it does need a few years for the whole-bunch character to settle down, after which, it will sing.

#### 2014 'Seville' Syrah

Sourced from a vineyard nestled in the foothills of the cool southern vales of the Yarra Valley where the grey loam soils show seams of deep red volcanic clay.

This is certainly the most charming and immediately approachable wine in this strong line-up. The nose is full and mesmerising with all-encompassing notes of crushed rocks, dark fruits, liquorice, violets and a rich dark chocolate character. The palate is full-flavoured and expansive, gracing every part of the mouth with blackberry and violets and a fine web of pliant tannins. The 'Seville' is such an impressive wine. You can drink it now with pleasure, but it has all the attributes necessary to ensure a long and lustrous stay in the cellar.

#### 2014 'Garden Gully' Syrah

75% Whole-bunch, sourced from a late-19th century Shiraz vineyard in Great Western.

The old vines, a special site and a favourable growing season have taken this wine to a new level in 2014. The 'Garden Gully' is a modern interpretation of a classic Great Western Shiraz, interplaying red clay and dark fruit characters with the undeniable Jamsheed whole-bunch stamp. The 'Garden Gully' possesses palate-coating concentration and flavour, finishing with very long and firm mouth-puckering tannin. The flavour lingers for 30 seconds. Give this one a few years in bottle for the tannins to settle.

#### 2014 'Pyren' Syrah

Sourced from vines planted on the quartz laced pink granitic soils of the Pyren vineyard in the township of Warrenmang in the Pyrenees.

The darkest, most brooding of all the Jamsheed wines – savoury and powerful. Possesses a similar aromatic spectrum to the 'Seville' (Liquorice, black fruits), but carries greater intensity and far more mineral character that speaks proudly of the quartz laced pink granitic soil it heralds from. Again, tastes of minerals and black fruits, finishing with impressively fine, long tannin. This is a beast of a wine, yet carries its power with such finesse and balance. Lock this one in the cellar alongside the 'Garden Gully' and 'Beechworth' – reassess in 3 years.
