Felton Road Block 5 Pinot Noir is one of the great wines of New Zealand. In exceptional years it rivals some of the best Pinot's from around the world for sheer class and unique character. Block 5 is medium to full-bodied, tightly wound and unyielding in its youth, unfurling with time in bottle to convey exceptional opulence and depth of flavour.

These wines have been sourced from an avid private collector, all stored under perfect temperature controlled conditions since release and it should be noted, all wines are bottled under screwcap! We also have a small volume of the current release available for sale at a very competitive price.

It must be stressed that we only have a small amount of each vintage, so in some cases we may only be able to provide 1 or 2 bottles of each wine. 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The Wines

Grapes are sourced from an organically farmed single-vineyard – 'Block 5' – of mature vines (now over 20 years old). 25% whole clusters are retained for fermentation with indigenous yeast. The wine sees 35% new French oak and is bottled after 17 months in barrel. The wine is neither fined nor filtered.

2007 Block 5 Pinot Noir

"Deep ruby-purple colour. Complex aromas of black pepper, cumin, warm cranberry, raspberry and dark chocolate. Medium to high acidity and a medium+ level of very finely grained tannins. Creamy oak – still jutting out but this wine is very young. Great concentration and intensity. Very long finish. 94 Points." – Lisa Perroti-Brown, Wine Advocate

"Darkest of all. Intense darker fruit but also a little stemmy. Firm and savoury on the palate with beautiful fruit line and length. Really moreish and avoids that oversweetness of red fruit that I sometimes find in New Zealand Pinots – though more often in those from Marlborough. 18 Points" – Jancis Robinson

2008 Block 5 Pinot Noir

"Deep ruby colored, the 2008 Block 5 Pinot Noir gives intense aromas of warm raspberries, dried herbs, underbrush, tree moss, rose petals, pepper and a whiff of fennel seed. Crisp, medium to full bodied with a medium level of silky tannins, the concentration of flavors here is profound, contributing to the very long, earthy finish. 93 Points." – Lisa Perroti-Brown, Wine Advocate

2009 Block 5 Pinot Noir

"Medium-deep ruby-purple colored, the 2009 Block 5 Pinot Noir is a little mute, offering delicate notes of black cherries, blackberries and mulberries with nuances of Provence herbs, underbrush and soy. Medium to full bodied, it gives plenty of mouth-filling fruit layers supported by refreshing acid and a medium to firm level of fine-grained tannins. The finish is long with some toasty / savory notes showing through. 93 Points." – Lisa Perroti-Brown, Wine Advocate

"Dark crimson. Very fine, heady and opulent on the nose. Lovely compact allure. Sweet start and beautifully sculpted. Reminds me a bit of a top Ata Rangi. Very complete, quite ready. Starts sweet, finishes dry. Long. Covers all bases. 17 Points" – Jancis Robinson

2014 Block 5 Pinot Noir

"Pale ruby colored with a hint of purple, the 2014 Block 5 Pinot Noir is a little reticent and broody at this youthful stage, with faint notes of pomegranate, red cherries and raspberry leaves plus a touch of forest floor. Light to medium-bodied, it offers restrained red berry, floral and earth laced flavors with very finely grainy, silky tannins and lovely freshness, finishing with great length. 93+ points." – Lisa Perroti-Brown, Wine Advocate
